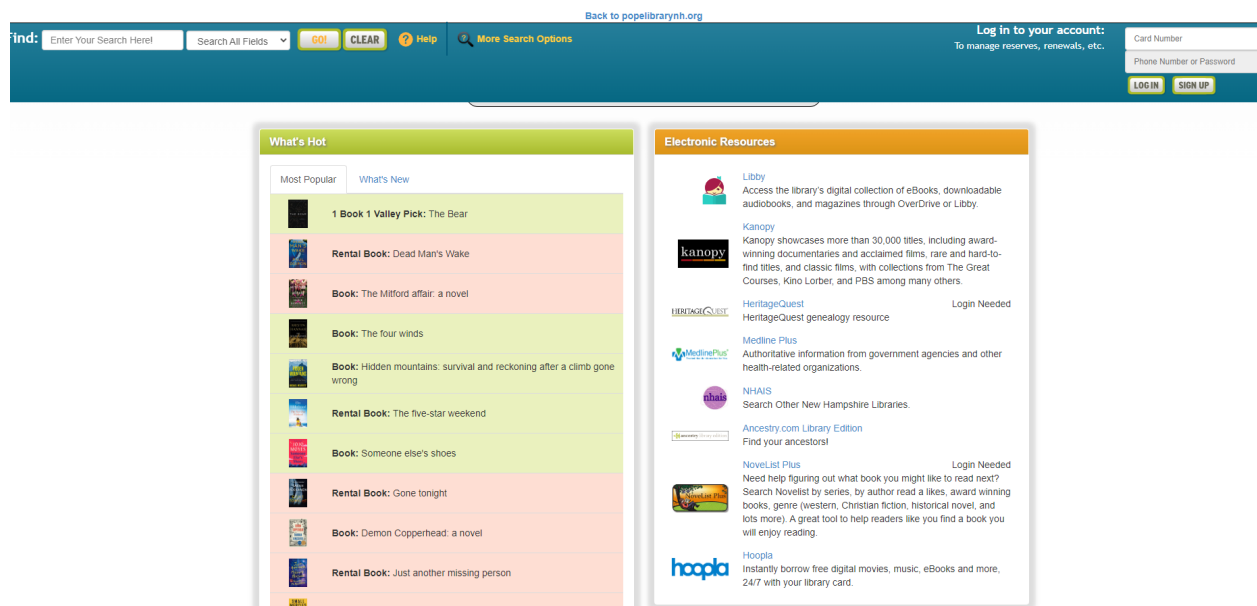

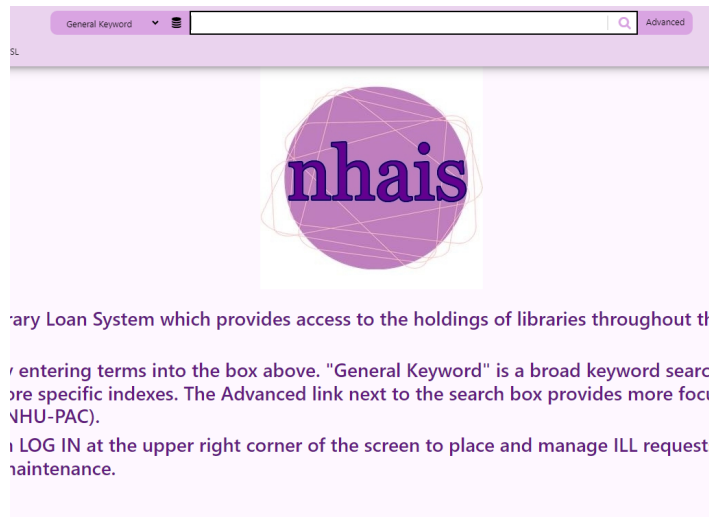
In the dropdown menu, select "Pope"

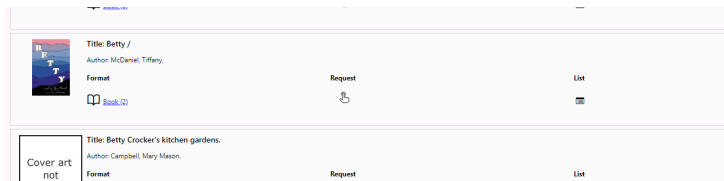
In the Username field, enter your 4 digit library card number
